

Procedures for reporting suspected sexual violence/sexual abuse in the diocese of Mainz If you are affected or become aware of an incident of sexualised violence / sexual abuse<sup>\*</sup>, an ongoing investigation or a conviction, please contact one of the independent contact persons or the Coordination Office for Intervention in the Episcopal Office. All church employees are obliged to make such a report if they become aware of it in an official context outside of a confessional or explicitly pastoral conversation.



\*\*Provided that this does not hinder the clarification of the facts and the investigative work of the prosecution authorities. During the investigations by the public prosecutor's office, the diocese will not undertake any investigations of its own.
